

The Winnebago Pool Lakes make up the largest inland freshwater lake system in Wisconsin

The four lakes cover 166,000 acres and contain 17 percent of the surface waters in the state

The lakes provide drinking water to over 200,000 people

The Winnebago Lakes Council was formed in 2005 in response to recommendations from a workshop on the Environmental Quality of Our Lakes and Shorelines hosted by the Oshkosh Area Community Foundation. Participants from 40 local groups, recognizing the importance of the Winnebago Pool lakes to the area, drafted a plan to involve local citizens in promoting the long-term sustainability of lakes Winnebago, Buttes des Morts, Winneconne and Poygan.
